IX. Meetings

2. Subject to the provisions of applicable law and the Beta Beta Chapter Rules regarding notice of meetings, members of any committee or membership as a whole may, unless otherwise restricted by statute, participate in and hold any such meeting of the chapter or committee by using conference telephone or similar communications equipment, or another suitable electronic communications system, including videoconferencing technology or the Internet, or any combination, if the telephone or other equipment system permits each person participating in the meeting to communicate with all other persons participating in the meeting.

If voting is to take place at the meeting, reasonable measures must be implemented to verify that every person voting at the meeting by means of remote communications is sufficiently identified and a record must be kept of any vote or other action taken. Any requirement for a ballot vote will be waived when the vote is taken at an electronic meeting, unless the technology used is capable of handling a ballot vote.

Rationale:

Because Beta Beta will use e-meetings, the chapter needs to update its meeting rule to include all types of meetings we hold.
