CONTEST SCHEDULE

The contest is announced in October.

Be sure to fill in all areas for chapter name, contact person, address, dates for submission to chapter, and your chapter committee members **before duplicating** the 7/8th grade procedure packet for distribution.

Chapter members will deliver or send a procedure packet to each school's English department.
Where possible the member will distribute packets to individual teachers.
Essays must be in the hands of the state committee by <u>March 1</u> . (Date)
Three to five chapter members will serve as judges.
After initial screening, remaining essays will be read and ranked by all judges.
Essays will not be returned to the writers.
State winners should be announced by April 1 (Date)
Thank you letters should be sent to all teachers who participate.

Oral readings of winning essays could be entertainment at the chapter's meeting and at the state leadership conference.

Announcements of winners should be mailed to local newspapers and participating schools.

Guidelines

A procedures packet is provided for each chapter. Chapters may make necessary changes as needed with the following exceptions: **TOPIC and JUDGING CRITERIA.**

All chapters must use the topic as stated for both seventh and eighth grade. This topic changes yearly.

Each chapter participating in the Oklahoma State Contest must **submit** their **first place** seventh grade winning essay and their **first place** eighth grade winning essay along with the **STATE PROJECT ENTRY FORMS** completely filled out.

Deadline for state entries must be to the committee, by email or USP mail, no later than March 1. Entries received after that date will not be judged.

The top STATE winners (seventh and eighth) will be invited to read their essays at the Oklahoma State Conference/Convention.

Each state winner will receive a cash prize and a certificate.

In areas where there is more than one chapter, chapters should coordinate their efforts to be able to reach all of the schools.

Certificates will be presented to each participating chapter at the luncheon.

Chapters with the top winners will be notified by letter in April.

Chapters will earn points toward the CHAPTER EXCELLENCE AWARD.

November to February Your chapter will hold local contests and local

prizes awarded to 7th and 8th grade no later than

February.

March 1st deadline Mail your local winning first place 7th and first

place 8th grade essays, along with the STATE PROJECT ENTRY FORM, to the Oklahoma State Essay Chairman, to be received no later than March 1.

March 1 State Committee will judge the essays submitted.

April 1 State Winners will be notified by April 1.

State winners: seventh and eighth grade winners will read their essays at Oklahoma State

Convention/Conference.
